The Board of Directors of the Society is pleased to announce that the last print in the series is now available. This print project began in 2006 and has been the initiative of the National Capital Region member Mr. Dave Brush in order to provide a fundraising opportunity for the Society. The purpose of this fundraising is to assist the Society in the support and further development of existing and new security programs, provide bursaries to deserving students enrolled in LASA college programs and to enable the Society to continue to fulfill its roles and responsibilities on behalf of the Canadian security profession across Canada.

Mr. Brush commissioned international and well known artist Mr. Bruce Bezaire for this purpose. The series of four seasonal prints are now complete and available for members and associates to purchase. While the first three prints were numbered from 1 to 100, the final print for the fall season is titled "Black's Rapids on the Rideau Canal" and is numbered 1-80. All prints are 9"x15" in size, signed by the artist and are ready for framing. We are extremely honoured, privileged and thankful to have Mr. Bezaire assist the Society.

As of this writing there are 8 (eight) full sets with the same print number available. There are still a number of individual prints available.

About Mr. Bruce Bezaire

Mr. Bezaire received his Bachelor of Arts from the University of Windsor Ontario and his Master of Fine Arts from Southern Illinois University. He is an artist, writer, illustrator and professor. Mr. Bezaire currently teaches at the O'More College of Design in Franklin Tennessee.

Mr. Bezaire has been a muralist, botanical illustrator and diorama painter for the Canadian Museum of Nature in Ottawa from 1978-1991, completed a large mural for the City of Essex Ontario in 1995 and has had painting shows at the Merton Gallery in Toronto, the Beckett Gallery in Hamilton Ontario and as far away as Seoul South Korea. Many of his paintings and etchings have been selected as award winners in juried shows throughout Canada, the United States and abroad.

His works can be found in private, corporate and public collections in Ontario, British Columbia, Manitoba and Alberta, in several states in the USA and in South Korea.

Purchase of the Prints

Prints may be purchased for a sum of \$50 each, which includes all taxes and shipping. A receipt for the purchase will be issued. If you have purchased the first three prints in this series, the final print will be offered for only \$25. Approximately \$40 from every print sold will go directly to the Society.
