WHAT TOPICS ARE COVERED?

The course of study includes:

- **Administration** – Planning, organizing, team leadership & program verification.
- **Physical Security** – Employment screening through to employee I.D. programs.
- **Protection of Information** – All aspects from Classification to Audits.
- **Legal** – All aspects from source of Laws to Roles and Responsibilities for prosecution.
- **Investigations** – Covering principles and procedures to operations and report writing.
- **Emergency Planning** – Discusses the various types of emergencies and types and elements of the plans to deal with them.
- **Industrial Relations** – Covers legislation and policy issues, strikes and disputes, health and safety issues and employee satisfaction.
- **Information Technology Security** – Covers Issues of Threat and Risk awareness and the essentials of information security.

HOW MUCH DOES THE COURSE COST?

The Security Supervisors Course is an educational program. Upon successful completion you will receive a Certificate. The Course is an educational tax deduction. 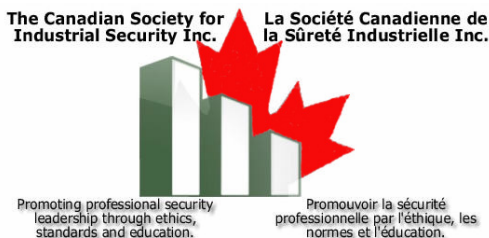
